CONTEXT OF SCHOOL

This is a larger than average-size primary school. Most pupils are White British and very few pupils are from minority ethnic groups. The proportion of pupils supported through school action plus and with a statement of special educational needs is well below average. The proportion of pupils eligible for pupil premium funding, which provides additional funding for pupils in local authority care, children from service families and those eligible to receive free school meals is well below average.
